Torkil Damhaug (1958-) has a degree in medicine with a specialization in psychiatry. His debut novel, *The Flight of the Moon* (Flykt, måne) caused a great stir when it was published in 1996. His Norwegian and international break-through came with the psychological thriller *Death by Water* (Døden ved vann) in 2009. The novel has since been optioned for a movie. For the novel *Fireraiser* (Ildmannen), Damhaug was awarded the prestigious Riverton Prize for best crime fiction novel in 2011. He was again awarded the Riverton Prize 2016 for the crime novel *A Fifth Season*.
