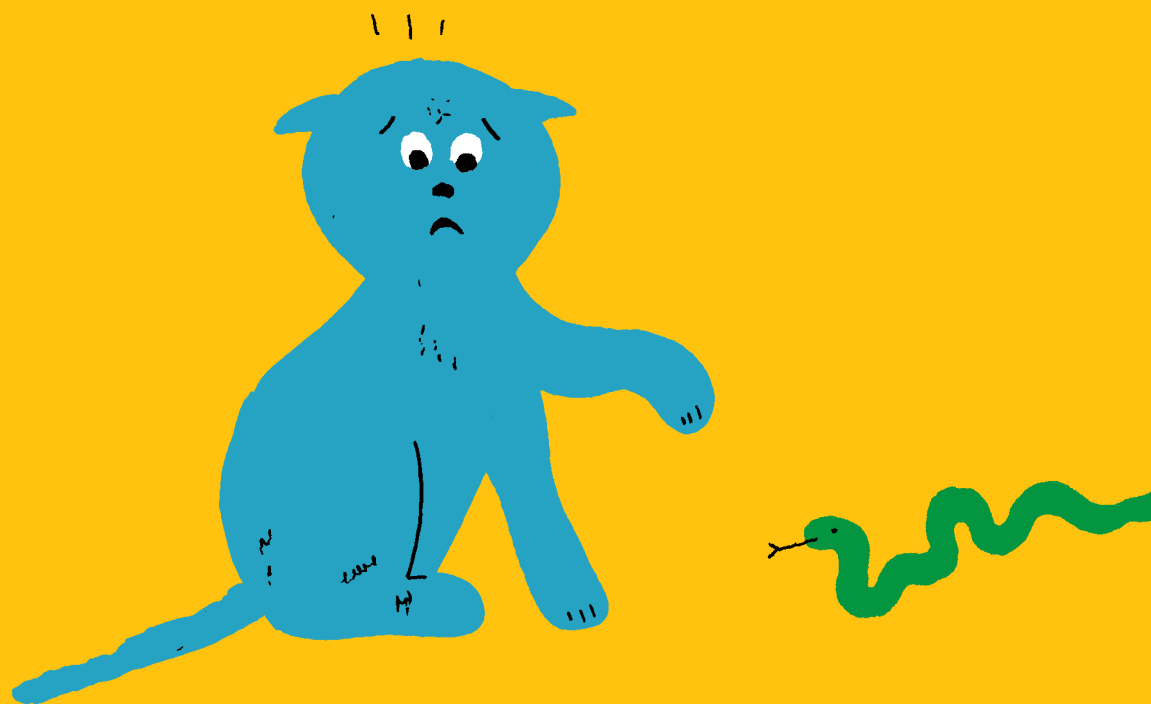
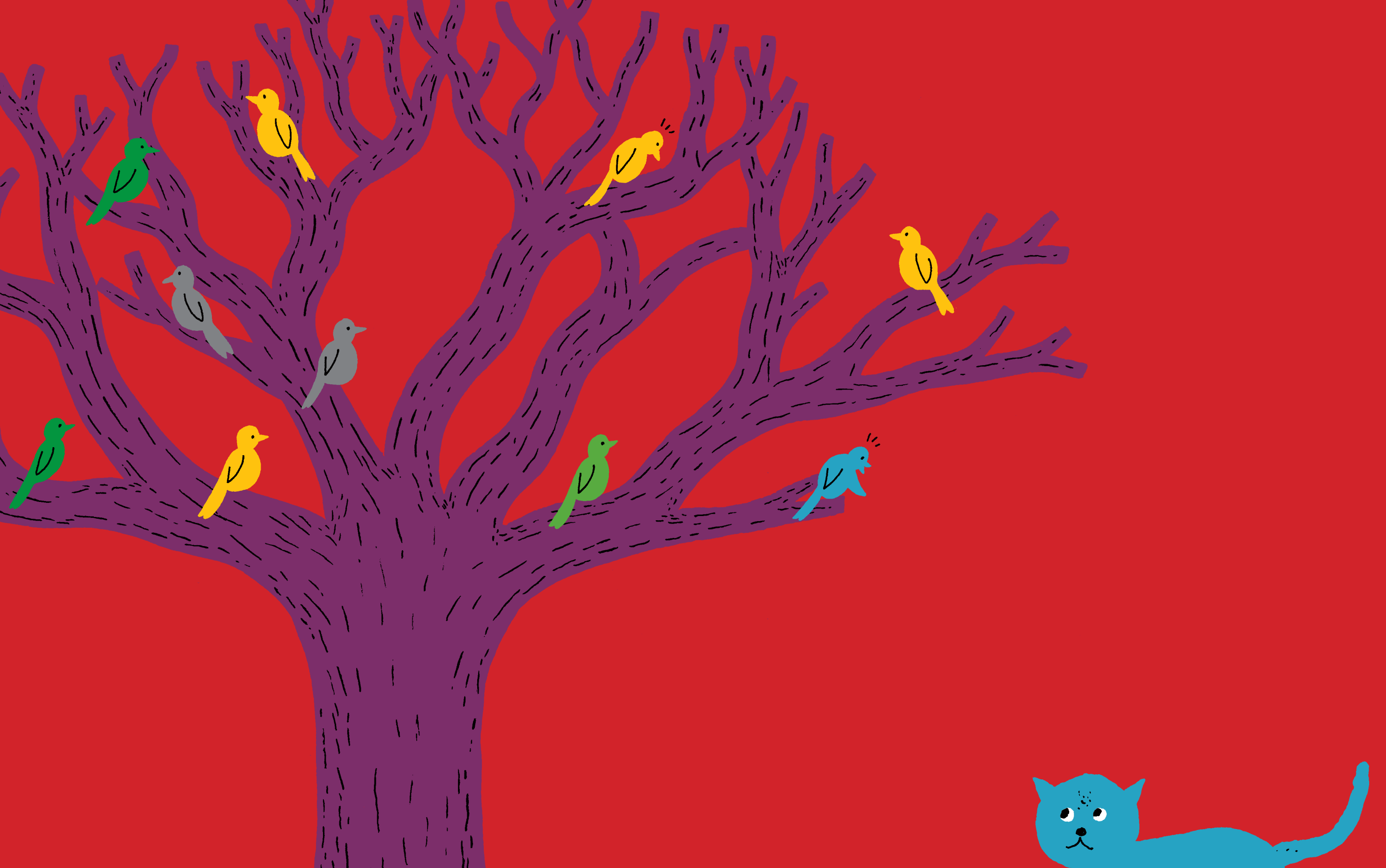

Every daddy and every mummy and every child.



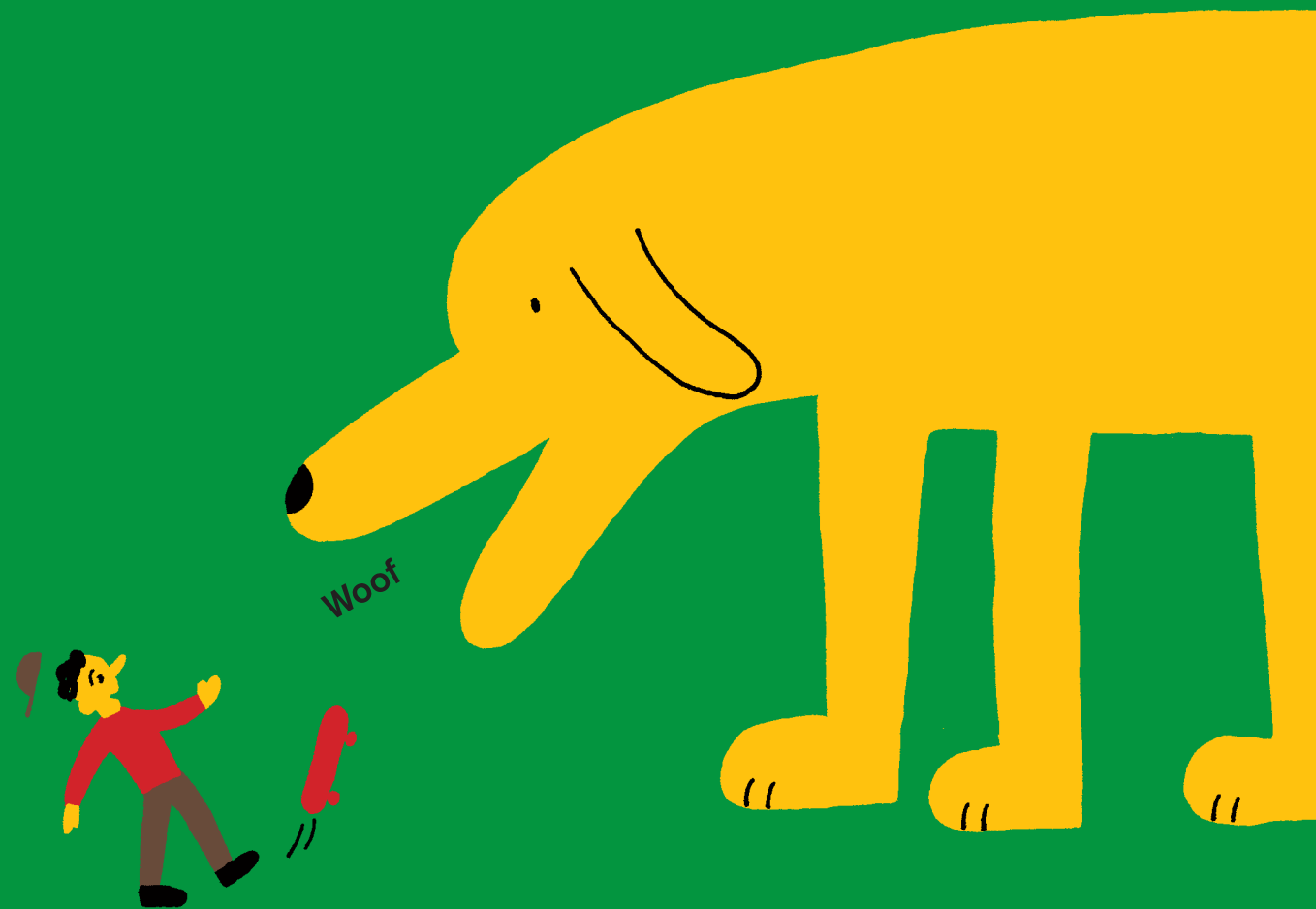
Not always, but sometimes.

A hip hop guy might be scared that a big dog will come along.



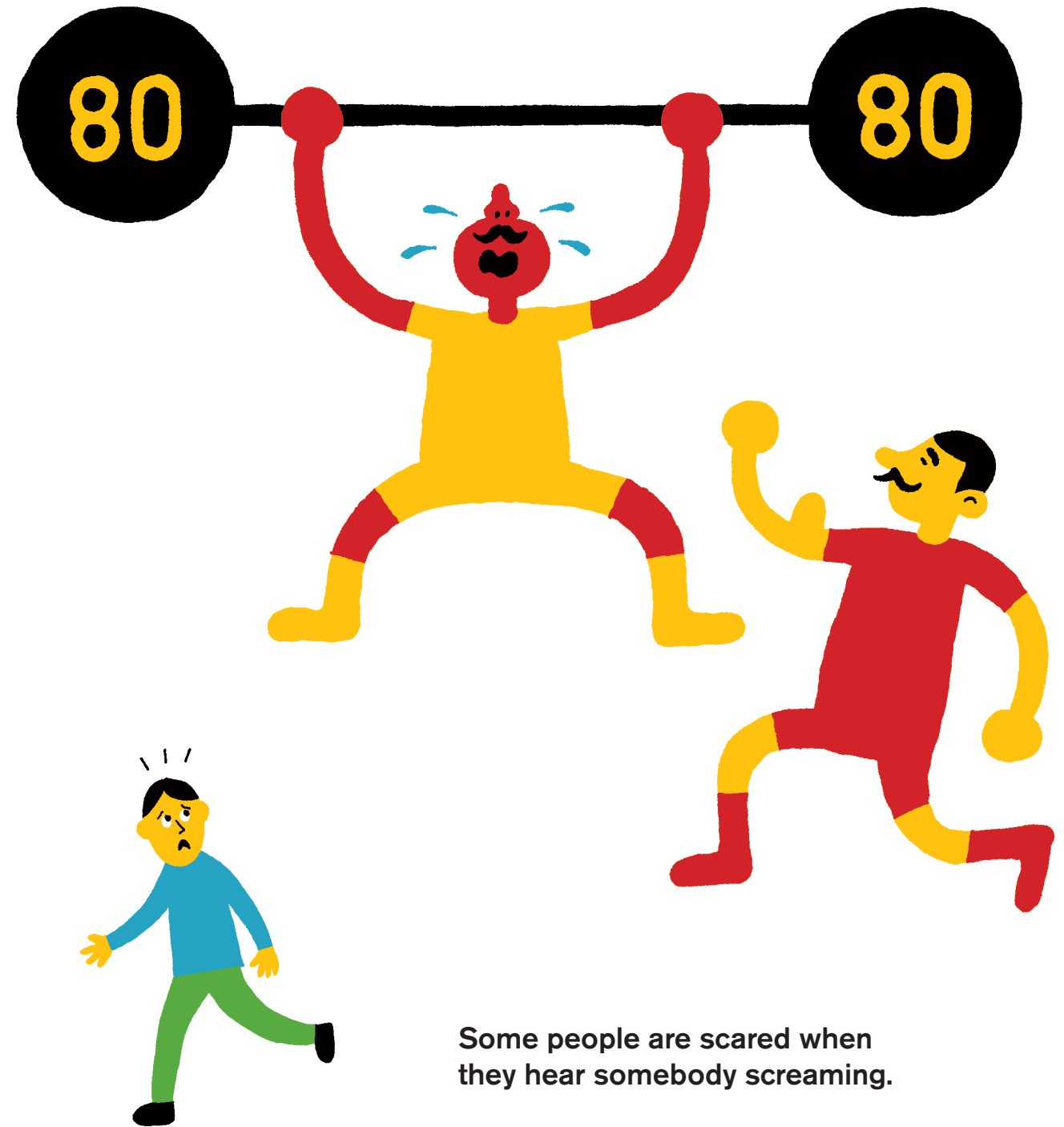


Some are scared when the rain pours down for a very long time.
