





Target audience:

Written for boys aged 8–13, but girls love it too.



Number of books: 8 books have been published so far.

Genre: A fantasy series grounded in the real world. The main characters, Tobias, Adam, and Tara, take readers on a journey to the underworld, where monsters from Norse mythology and folklore emerge one by one as threatening antagonists.

Why the series works for the screen: The books are written in a very cinematic style, with fast-paced storytelling and cliffhangers in every chapter. They are thrilling while also building highly believable characters.


Film or TV series: The books are well-suited for adaptation into either a TV series (similar to *Wednesday*) or multiple feature films (like the *Harry Potter* movies).

Animation or live-action: These stories would benefit from an animated background, which could be done cost-effectively using motion capture. However, the characters should be portrayed by live actors. A hybrid approach—where the backgrounds and monsters are created with motion capture while the main characters are live-action—could work well.



Arne Lindmo is best at action sequences and jumps straight in, leaving young readers breathless from the very first page! 'This is an absolutely necessary quality in a writer today,' says publisher Anitra Figenschou. 'Children today are used to constant excitement. They don't have the patience kids had when I was a child,' she continues.

Arne Lindmo worked for many years as a teacher. He used to invent scary short stories that he was telling the students in his class to keep them awake during Norwegian lessons. Sometimes his stories kept students up at night too!

Not only is Lindmo good at action, he also manages to describe the three main characters in a way that really makes you like them and want to read more! 'We also see this as a key to success,' continues publisher Figenschou. 'Just think of the series we get hooked on, on Netflix, HBO and Disney+. Those are the series where the main characters are multidimensional, and you constantly want to get to know them better.'





REPRESENTATION

Adam is half Polish and half Moroccan, Tara's parents are from India, and Tobias' family is Norwegian on both sides. Representation in children's books is hugely important, though often difficult to achieve. Lindmo draws knowledge from his experience as a teacher in Oslo schools with children from all over the world, and he has many friends in the local community who can help proofread quotes in Polish and Hindi.





BOOK 1: TROLLHEIM – Secret of Castle Crow

Main characters: Adam, Tara and Tobias Important character: Kark the troll

<u>Antagonists/Monsters:</u> Hel, the Midgard Serpent and Fenrir the Wolf

Mysterious things are going on in the small town of Trollheim. The children talk in hushed voices about scary things in the woods. Three friends, Adam, Tara and Tobias, are facing the longest and most dangerous night of their lives. If they are to survive until dawn, they must discover the secret of Castle Crow and do battle with an ancient evil before the whole world is lost.



BOOK 2: TROLLHEIM – Avenger from Helheim

Main characters: Adam, Tara and Tobias
Important characters: The families of the three friends
Antagonists/Monsters: Helene (Hel's daughter) and Viktor
(Werewolf). In this book Tara turns into a werewolf also
and becomes her own worst enemy.

Adam, Tara and Tobias have pledged to protect Trollheim from the evil lurking beneath the surface. They soon face a challenge that will not only test their courage and strength, but also their friendship. Mysterious tracks in the woods and strange howls at the moon are ominous enough, but little do they know the greatest danger is one they can neither see nor hear.



BOOK 3: TROLLHEIM – Underground Mission

<u>Main characters:</u> Adam, Tara and Tobias <u>Important characters:</u> Zira the vampire, Odin, and Tara's little brother, Bablu

<u>Antagonists/Monsters:</u> Trolls (big/small), Zaxigyll the dragon and Loki (the devil himself). The Trolls kidnap Taras little brother, and the children goes underground to save him!

When a dear family member is kidnapped, Adam, Tara and Tobias risk everything to free him. They must climb deep underground, all the way to Helheim! Trolls, dragons and Loki himself stand in their way, and other dangers also lurk in the dark tunnels ... A pale girl crawling around looking for blood, who even the biggest trolls are afraid of.



BOOK 4: TROLLHEIM – Vampires and demons

Main characters: Adam, Tara, Tobias and Zira

Important characters: Silje and Frank

Antagonists/Monsters: In this book the bullies at school are

the real monsters. Represented by Frank and his gang.

Adam, Tara and Tobias have a new friend, but she's a vampire and hasn't been on the surface in 200 years! Can they keep her identity a secret? Will she fit in at school? And can they stop her from murdering the mean bullies in the class? The problems get worse and worse, especially when the class superstar falls in love with Adam. She will stop at nothing to win his heart, including making deals with the darkest powers...

This is a classic "fish out of water"-story.



Book 5: TROLLHEIM – The Queen of Spiders

Main characters: Adam, Tara, Tobias, and Zira
Key characters: Siblings Frank and Silje
Antagonists/MONSTERS: Arakhne, the Queen of
Spiders, is the main monster in this tale, well-assisted
by Medusa. Investigator Fredriksen is also a central
antagonist.

An intense police investigation is underway in Trollheim. Two children have disappeared without a trace, and rumors circulate about a vampire in the village. In an attempt to sort things out, Adam, Tara, and Tobias journey to Helheim to find the missing children. There, a new monster has emerged:

Arakhne, the Queen of Spiders! A ruthless creature who desires conquest and dominion, yet she is also lonely, constantly searching for a girl who, with a little help, can become her perfect eight-legged daughter!



Book 6: TROLLHEIM – The Curse in Troll Forest

Main characters: Adam, Tara, Tobias, and Zira
Key characters: The bully Roger becomes a friend but meets a
fatal fate

<u>Antagonists/MONSTERS:</u> Mårg, the man who has bought himself eternal life in a gruesome way. He is guarded by an army of undead animals with only black holes for eyes

Tara's parents want to buy a new cabin, but it's suspiciously cheap. Tara volunteers to test the cabin for a week. She looks forward to starting her summer vacation with a cozy cabin trip with all her friends. She's especially excited to spend time with Tobias. But the cabin hides a gruesome secret—a curse. And deep inside Troll Forest, miles from the nearest neighbor and without phone coverage, the group of friends begins to realize that something is terribly wrong...



Book 7: TROLLHEIM - The Journey to Atlantis

Main characters: Adam, Tara, Tobias, and Zira
Key characters: The marine biologist Daniel, who arrives in
Trollheim with big news
Antagonists/MONSTERS: Kraken and the People of Atlantis

There is a place in the Atlantic Ocean that no one dares to cross. Sailors speak of a terrifying monster with long tentacles, and more ships have disappeared there than in the Bermuda Triangle. Deep down lies the ruins of an 8,000-year-old secret. A lost kingdom that was destroyed and sank to the bottom of the sea.

Tobias loves the myth of Atlantis. When he discovers that a mysterious portal leads there, he has to take a look. Soon he, Adam, Tara, and Zira are off on a new adventure. But the portal is a one-way ticket, and trapped at the bottom of the sea, cold and wet, they must find a way home.



Book 8: TROLLHEIM - The Witch of the Water Spirit's Marsh

Main characters: Adam, Tara, Tobias, and Zira
Key characters: Silje who decides to host a grand Halloween
party in the Crow's Castle
Antagonists/MONSTERS: The Witch of the Water Spirit's Marsh

Halloween is to be celebrated with a class party at the old crow's castle, and everyone is looking forward to it. But strange things begin to stir. Black cats attack, and a crow with green eyes spies on them. Only Adam, Tara, Tobias, and Zira can stand against the darkness that has crept into Trollheim—but they must hurry, or this year's All Hallows' Night may twist into a nightmare from which no one can escape.

Illustrator of the TROLLHEIM books Ida Skjelbakken won the prize for the year's best illustrations from The Ministry of Culture!



Christmas Heist tells the story of four poor street children who want to celebrate the best Christmas ever, but first, they must pull off the biggest Christmas heist of all time. On a deserted island, an old, grumpy millionaire, Gregor Twist, is preparing a peculiar Christmas ritual: decorating for Christmas with gifts, food, and decorations from around the world, only to burn everything on Christmas Eve. The four poor street children, Lukas, Emma, Karoline, and Malik, decide to help themselves to some of the food and presents on the night before Christmas Eve. The carefully planned heist involves putting a tiger to sleep, hacking the alarm system, and climbing down the chimney, but nothing goes as planned, and the children soon find themselves struggling to survive. As if things weren't scary enough, Gregor Twist's mansion seems to be haunted. The book is full of action, adventure, humor, and Christmas spirit.
