TRUDE TEIGE

IN 2015, THE historical novel Grandma Danced in the Rain was published and cemented Trude Teige among international bestselling authors. Inspired by actual people and events, the book was nominated for The Norwegian Booksellers' Prize and the trilogy has sold over 130.000 copies in Norway alone. It became one of the bestselling books in Germany in 2023 and remained on the bestseller list for over a year.

IN THE FALL of 2021, Teige followed up with When Grandpa Breathed With the Waves, an epic novel about an unknown piece of history. The novel went straight onto both Norwegian and German bestseller charts. In the fall of 2024, Teige rounded out her popular trilogy with Until We Meet Again By the Sea. A moving story that shines a light on female forced labour in Norway for the very first time on a grander scale.

TRUDE TEIGE IS well known from the Norwegian TV channel TV2, where she was a presenter, news anchor and political reporter for 22 years. She debuted in 2002 with her first novel and is the author behind the enormously successful crime series about TV journalist Kajsa Coren. A Norwegian Nazi soldier is the only one who gives her the feeling of having value as a human being until Nadia finds out: she is pregnant. Birgit and Nadia's paths cross during these years. Both are friends of Juni's grandmother, and like her, they hide their stories from the world. When the war is over, the story continues in Bodø, Oslo, Moscow and on the Intelligence Service's farm in Gudbrandsdalen.

UNTIL WE MEET Again By the Sea is a story about friendship that makes life worth living despite great trials – a novel about hope, strength and fateful love.


