Esther van Hulsen (b. 1981) is a Dutch artist, painter and nature illustrator living in Norway. She is a graduate of the Kunstacademie Minerva Groningen in The Netherlands. Van Hulsen has illustrated a number of award-winning non-fiction books for children about prehistoric animals.
