Ulv Ulv Tommy Skoglund (b. 1982) debuted in 2009 with the prose poem-collection *Waking up as Part of Nature*: "Impressive. With each new reading, the admiration for the author's distinctive talent increases, where the crystal clear and the irrational meet in concrete descriptions and paradoxical formulations" (VG, 5/6). In 2014 he debuted as a novelist with *Silent Rebellion*, the story of a self-chosen mute antihero, for which he was awarded a two-year-stipend from Arts Council Norway, and The Municipality Prize. In 2018 the novel was translated into Danish. In June 2022, the second book of the metafictional antinovel-cycle, *The Dilogy*, was published.



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
