Endre Lund Eriksen is an award-winning children's and young adult writer, screenwriter, playwright and director. He had his breakthrough with his debut *Pitbull-Terje går amok* (*Pitbull-Terje Goes Amok*) in 2002, translated to several languages and made into a very successful film (*Pitbullterje*, 2005). Many other titles have been translated to other languages, such as *"The Animal Detectives"* (2019), *The Dunderly* series (2011), *"The first man to pee on the moon"* (2009), *"Super"* (2009) and *"The summer my Dad turned gay"* (2012).



He is also directing and producing animated children's films.

Endre Lund Eriksen's books often use humor as a tool to approach serious topics in a way that's accessible, without trivializing them. He tackles difficult subjects like
