



Gjermund the Wren and other noisy birds is an imaginative and playful gateway to the close and accessible Norwegian bird fauna for children. Author Lisbeth Dreyer has taken as her starting point quite ordinary birds that live quite ordinary bird lives, but has composed amusing situations in rhyme.

The book conveys the material in a way that both challenges, engages and inspires children to notice the bustling bird life that they have right outside their door, on their way to kindergarten and school.

Per Ragnar Møkleby makes the birds personable, but always grounded in how they actually look and live in nature – so that children can learn about and recognize the birds in the book.

The book is sure to spark interest in these elusive creatures that fly in flocks, gather in the square, and build nests in trees. The birds live their lives side by side with us, but can still feel distant. The book inspires readers to become more observant of what is happening in nature.
